Life Cycle of the Cat Flea *Ctenocephalides felis*



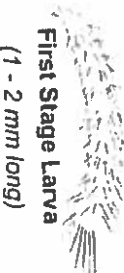
Eggs

Eggs laid on pet (25 - 40 eggs per day).

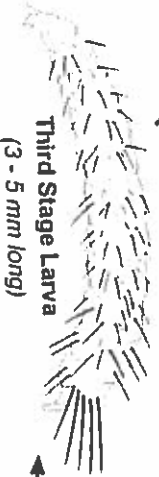
Eggs fall of pet and hatch in environment.

Hatch in 2 - 5 days.



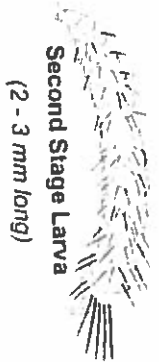
First Stage Larva

(1 - 2 mm long)



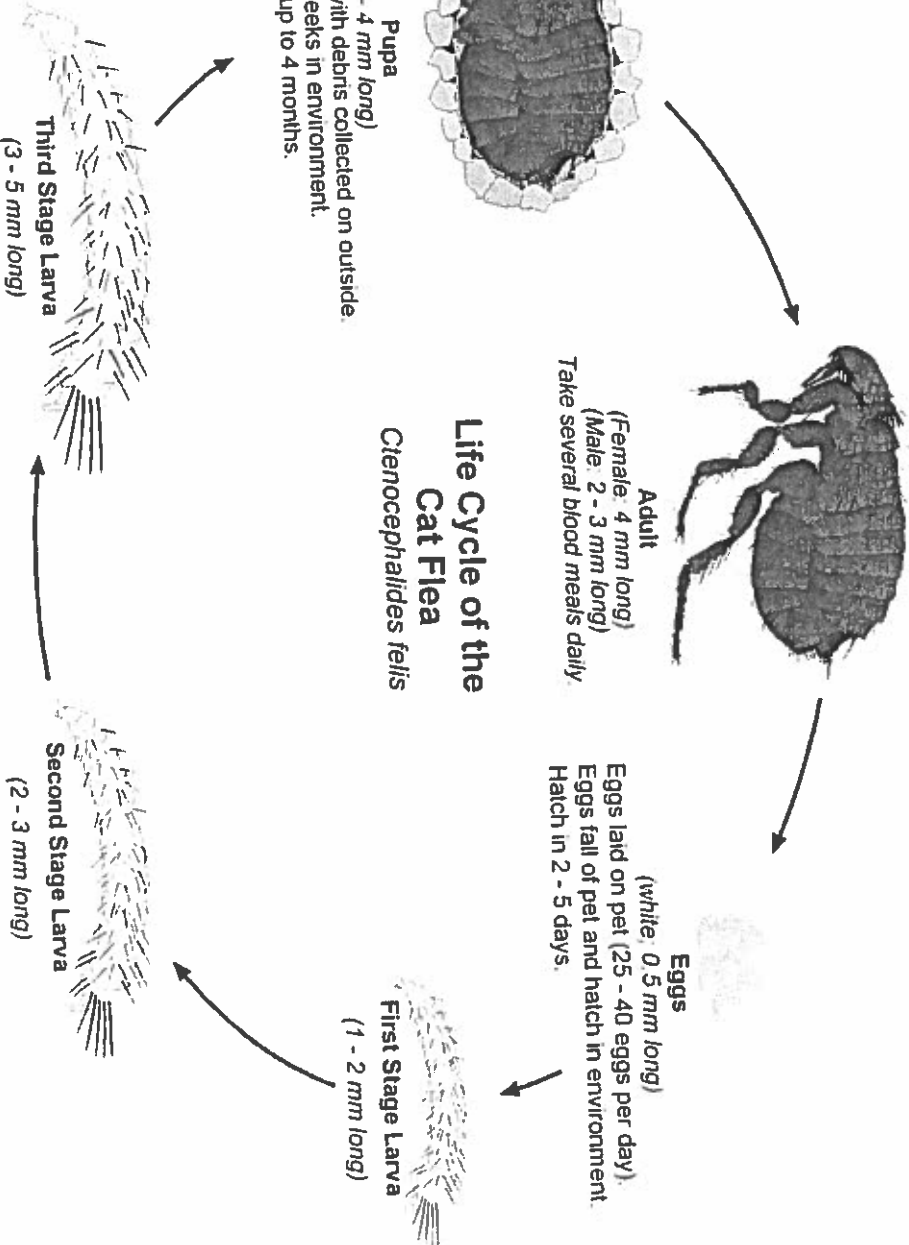
Third Stage Larva

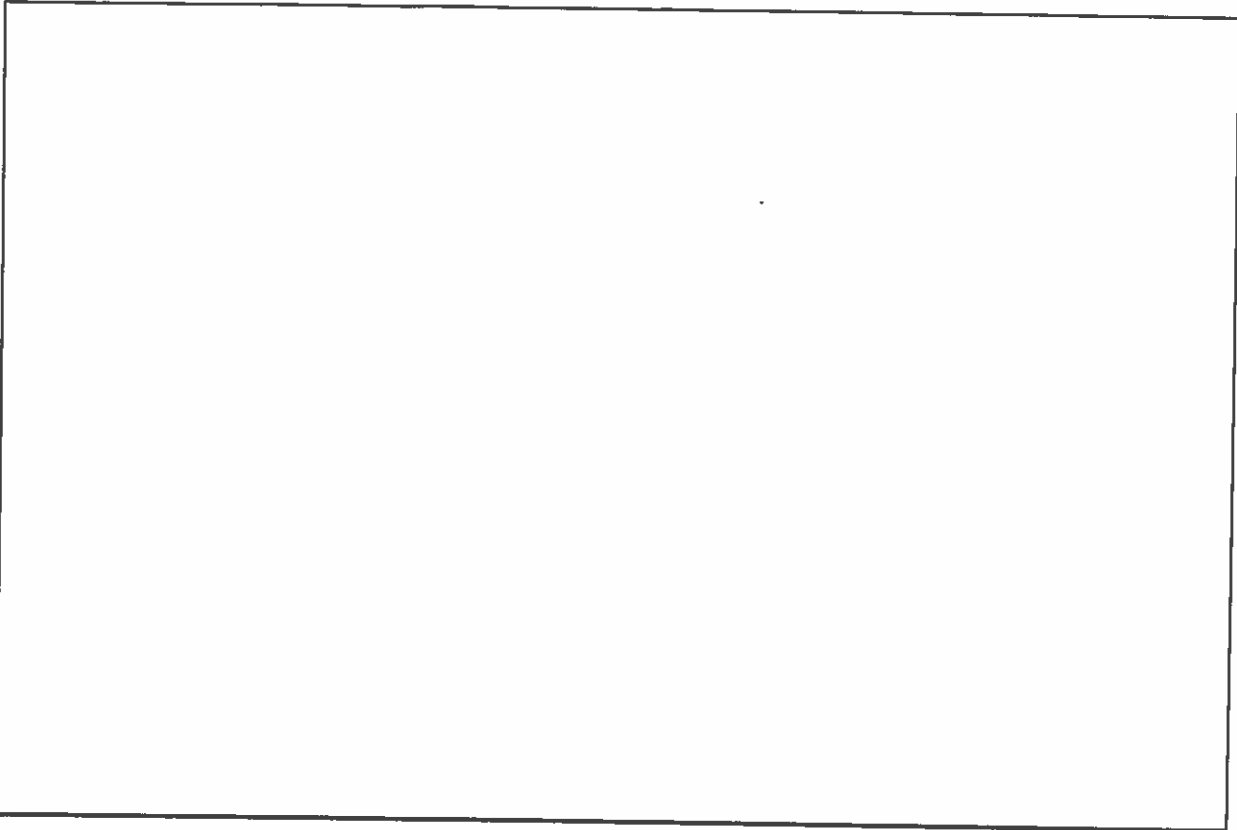
