

# Kindergarten Blizzard Bag

## Math

1. Orally count to 100 by 1's and by 10's.
2. Practice writing the numbers 0-20 out of order.

Parent says a number, and without looking at an example, the child writes it on the attached worksheet.

## Reading (This assignment is optional.)

3. Click on the BookFlix link.
4. Click on Resources. Then click on Title Browse.
5. Find the book Bear Has a Story to Tell and click on it.
6. Click on the following links Watch the Story (Bear Has a Story to Tell) and then Read the Story (This will be the nonfiction book How Do You Know It's Winter?).
7. Ask your child which story is fiction (make-believe). Ask him/her to tell you something from the story that tells us that it is fiction.

2. Choose 5 words from the following list:

3. Parent says the word, and the child will write them on the lines.

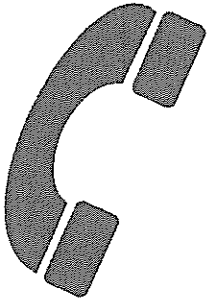
