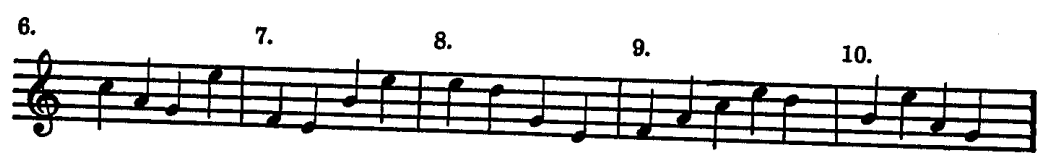

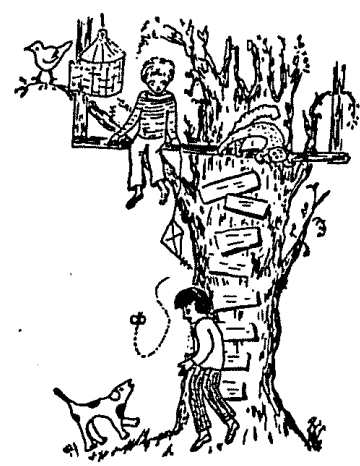
**10. A CAGEY PROBLEM**
